> **Environmental Credentials Statement** Ultrafelt is an environmentally responsible paper manufactured under strict environmental management systems using wind generated electricity and is made carbon neutral within Mohawks' production processes by offsetting thermal manufacturing emissions with Verified Emissions Reduction credits (VERs) and by purchasing enough Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs) to match 100% of the electricity used in their operations. The entire range uses Elemental Chlorine Free (ECF) pulps sourced from well managed forests combined with 30% post consumer fibre (that has been manufactured from PCF pulp).
